Health Regulations - Cattle will be checked in by State Animal inspectors prior to entry into the Mallary Complex. Health papers and Registration Certificates WILL be checked. All cattle must have an RFID tag for traceability. The State Animal Health Regulations can be viewed on this website: <http://www.mass.gov/eea/agencies/agr/animal-health/animal-imports-livestock-markets/>. (See note above - we are aware that this takes you to a page for 2020 rules but this is the most current version available and will be used for the 2021 show). All veterinarian test results must be presented upon request. Official health certificates must be presented at check-in for each animal on the fairgrounds. All registration papers and health papers must remain with the cattle!!
